Tanzania Safari 13 Nights / 14 Days

DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN TANZANIA

On this day of arrival, you will be met at Kilimanjaro International Airport /at your arrival point by our representative and safari manager. You will then be transferred to the Masailand Safari Lodge around Arusha, and after a quick Safari briefing, you will be able to relax for the rest of the night.

DAY 2- 4:TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, we will depart and drive to Tarangire National Park and the Theatre of the Wild in Tanzania. Tarangire is the third largest park in Tanzania and has a lot to offer in terms of wildlife and its awe-inspiring sights of the gigantic baobabs that dot the park. The Tarangire River is the lifeblood of this wonderful reserve and it ensures an abundance of wildlife along the river when they come to get a fair share of the valuable commodity especially in dry seasons. Animals you might see include lions, elephants, leopards, Oryx, dik-diks, and a wide range of birds species. Later in the afternoon, you will check-in at Tarangire Safari Lodge for dinner and your overnight stay.



DAY 5&6: LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

An early morning game drive is available if you wish (and trust us, it's worth it!), and after breakfast, we will depart Tarangire National Park for Lake Manyara National Park. Lake Manyara is a small beautiful national park famous for the legendary tree-climbing lions and many other large and small mammals. Lunch can be served at the numerous picnic sites in the park or if you wish you may go for hot lunch at the lodge before returning for game drives in the afternoon. We will drive into the late afternoon, and you will have dinner and stay overnight at The Retreat at Ngorongoro Karatu. All meals included.



DAY 7&8: NGORONGORO CRATER TOUR

After breakfast, we will drive through Karatu town to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. After registration at the Loduare Gate, we will drive up to the Crater rim and make our first stop at the View Point. Here you will have the most stunning views over the Crater floor then you embark on your descent down the 600-meter walls for game viewing. Here, in the world's largest unbroken caldera, if you are lucky, you will spot the 'Big Five' on the same day. Ngorongoro Crater is world-renowned for its unparalleled concentration of animals and birdlife. Among the species that you can spot freely include: zebras, topis, elands, warthogs, hartebeests, and many more. The list is endless. In the late afternoon, we will ascend up the Crater Rim to check in back at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge. All meals included.

DAY 9: OLDUVAI - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK.

After breakfast, we will check out of the lodge at Ngorongoro and drive to Olduvai Gorge where Dr. Louise and Mary Leaky discovered old fossils of a hominid called Australopithecus Boisei. This discovery led to the theory that Africa is the cradle of mankind, and at Olduvai Gorge, you will be lectured briefly about the theory and the discovery. After that, we will drive to Serengeti through the Naabi Hill Gate where you will stop briefly for registration. This day, you will take a picnic lunch and go ahead with the game drives in the plains for the rest of the afternoon then drive to the Serengeti Serena lodge for dinner and an overnight stay. All meals included.



DAY 10-12: FULL DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK.

Today, you will have the chance of going for a morning game drive at dawn (If you wish) to see nocturnal animals retiring and the diurnal species waking up for a new day under the beautiful African rising sun. We will then go back to the lodge /camp for breakfast then leave with a lunch box for a full day of game drives on the endless plains of Serengeti. Depending on the months that you have travel, you may witness the Great Migration that involves the movement of over a million and a half wildebeests together with zebras and gazelles in what is the largest mass movement of animals on the planet. Other resident animals include lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, topis, elands, dik-diks, baboons, and many more. Serengeti is also very popular for an amazingly large number of birds species. We will stay overnight at Serengeti Simba Lodge or a similar camp. All meals included.

DAY 13: SERENGETI TO ARUSHA

Before the sun rises, you have the chance to take one last expedition through the Serengeti Safari and see the nocturnal Serengeti animals return from a night hunt. You can enjoy your beautiful breakfast at the hippo pool picnic site. The hippo pool is a wonderful experience where you will watch these magnificent and often hilarious creatures in their natural habitat, frolicking and fighting in the pools, and dwarfing the occasional crocodile on the shore. After then drive to Arusha for dinner and overnight at the Grand Melia Hotel.



DAY 14-DEPARTURE

After your morning breakfast, your driver will be ready to take you to Kilimanjaro International airport for your flight back home.
