Please note that International Air Transportation from your home city to Johannesburg is not included in this proposal in order to provide passengers with the opportunity to use Frequent Flyer Miles or other Awards and/or to seek promotional airfares which are sometimes lower than our Contract rates. We are of course available to arrange this transportation, and provide ticketing for those who wish us to do so.

Day 1, USA/Johannesburg - suggested flight schedule

Depart from the USA this afternoon on your overnight flight across the great Atlantic Ocean. Enjoy the hospitality on board this evening as you dine aloft. (meals on board)



Day 2, Johannesburg

Transfer from Johannesburg Airport to Aero Guest Lodge for overnight – **Standard rooms on a BB basis**

Includes: Breakfast and free airport transfers Excludes: Any services not specified. Offering spacious rooms with private entrances, this lodge is set in lush gardens with an outdoor pool. Free airport transfers are provided to Johannesburg International Airport, a 5-minute drive away. Guests can relax by the large swimming pool or play some billiards. The thatched-roof terrace offers plenty of shade when the sun gets too hot. A selection of

fresh vegetables, game and salads are served daily in Aero's dining room. The bar offers a large variety of cooled drinks to enjoy in the garden.

Days 3-5,

Johannesburg/Pretoriuskop Rest Camp

Transfer from Aero Lodge to Johannesburg Airport to pickup your car rental (Toyota Quantum & trailer) Drive to Kruger National Park and Pretoriuskop Rest Camp. Accommodation at Pretoriuskop Rest Camp (TT) - RO Bungalow (BD2)Includes: Accommodation only. Excludes: Daily conservation fee and any services not specified. Offering some of the oldest accommodation in the Kruger National Park in a region known for its rich cultural history, Pretoriuskop Rest Camp provides guests with a choice of campsites, rustic two, three, five or six-bed huts, family cottages, guest cottages and guesthouse accommodation. Days are spent in search of the Big 5 and more on guided bush walks and game drives, accompanied by professional field guides.

Guests can also opt to join the Napi Wilderness Trail – must be booked in advance, the Sable Trail camp walk and the Madlabantu 4x4 Adventure Trail. The camp offers facilities such as a restaurant, cafeteria, curio shops, fuel station, laundry and communal kitchen and ablution facilities.





Days 6-8,
Pretoriuskop Rest Camp/Skukuza Rest Camp
Accommodation at Skukuza Rest Camp (TT) - RO
Bungalow, Max 2 pax (BD2)Includes: Accommodation
only.Excludes: Daily conservation fee and any services not
specified. Skukuza Rest Camp is the largest of the camps found
in the game-rich Kruger National Park. Built on the southern
banks of the Sabie River, this rest camp is known for its
proximity to big game, such as lions. As it is also the
administrative capital of the park, there are extensive facilities
available in the camp; these include a shop, ATM, internet cafe,

library, fuel station, delicatessen and two restaurants. Offering standard to luxury accommodation in campsites, 21 furnished safari tents, semi-luxury bungalows, four guesthouses and family cottages, the camp caters for all types of travellers. The common element between all guests is the desire to see the abundance of wildlife that lives here. Besides self-drive and guided safari drives around the park, guests can also opt for riverside walks, wilderness hikes and a round of golf on the 9-holecourse. There is also an outdoor amphitheatre, on-site museum and information centre.

Days 9-11, Skukuza Rest Camp/Berg-en Dal Rest Camp

Accommodation at Berg-en Dal Rest Camp (TT) - in a Rhino Guest House (GH8B) on a Room Only basis Includes: Accommodation only. Excludes: Daily conservation fee and any services not specified. Berg-en-Dal Rest Camp is one of the camps in the Kruger National Park that is well known for its extraordinary wealth of wildlife. Set among rocks on a hillside overlooking the Matjula Spruit, the camp offers comfortable and affordable accommodation in guest house rooms, bungalows as well as camping and caravan sites. Surrounded by wild Africa, you are welcome to explore the park on guided game drives, walking tours, birding excursions and more. Meals are served in the air-conditioned restaurant overlooking the dam or you can book for a private bush dinner under starry skies. There is a well-stocked grocery shop, laundromat and petrol station on site as well as an internet cafe and film auditorium. Other attractions include the San rock art found in the surrounding hills, the on-site curio shop and a large, inviting swimming pool.

Days 12-14, Berg-en Dal Rest Camp/Lions Rock Rapids Tented Camp

Accommodation at Lions Rock Rapids Tented Camp in a Luxury Tent - Includes: Accommodation only. Excludes: Lunch, drinks and any services not specified. Explorer Lions Rock Rapids is located on the banks of one of the most famous rivers in Africa, the Sabie River. It's a short drive from the adventure town of Hazyview and this camp is a central base to explore this part of the world and all it has to offer. You

could spend the day in the renowned Kruger National Park or quad biking, river rafting, even hot air ballooning. This area is also well known for the Panorama Route that includes the Blyde River Canyon and God's Window. The camp itself offers a reception, dining





area, lounge and bar as well as an open air boma right on the river. B/D

Day 15, Lions Rock Rapids Tented Camp/Aero Lodge

Day 16,

Johannesburg/Atlanta
